Jesus as Everlasting Father?

Thus God is addressed as Father in the Lord's Prayer (Matt. 6:9). It is "your Father who is in secret" who is addressed in prayer (6:18). It is "your heavenly Father" who "knows that you need all these things" (6:32). It is "the one who does the will of my Father in heaven" who will enter the kingdom of heaven (7:21). The disciples are to be perfect, "as your heavenly Father is perfect" (5:48).

Twice from the cross, moreover, Jesus addressed the Father: "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing" (Luke 23:34) and "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit" (Luke 23:46).

- And in the Fourth Gospel, he addressed his disciples as "little children" (John 13:33). It is to the little
 children that Jesus gives his radical commandment in the intimacy of the family, that they should
