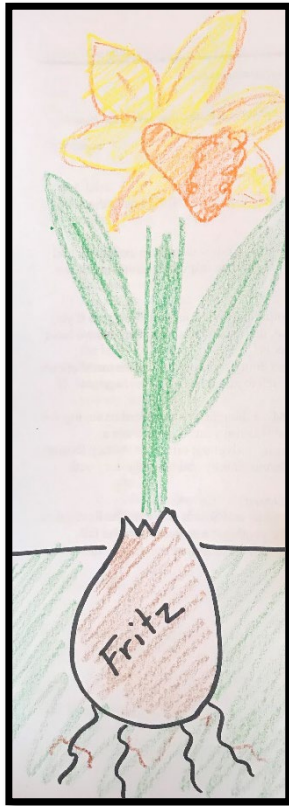


## ***Remembering the Saints***
